Men use their strength as advantage on women, knowing that they are placing forever stigma in that innocent person heart. Forcing a child to have sex with you is being wicked as the devil.

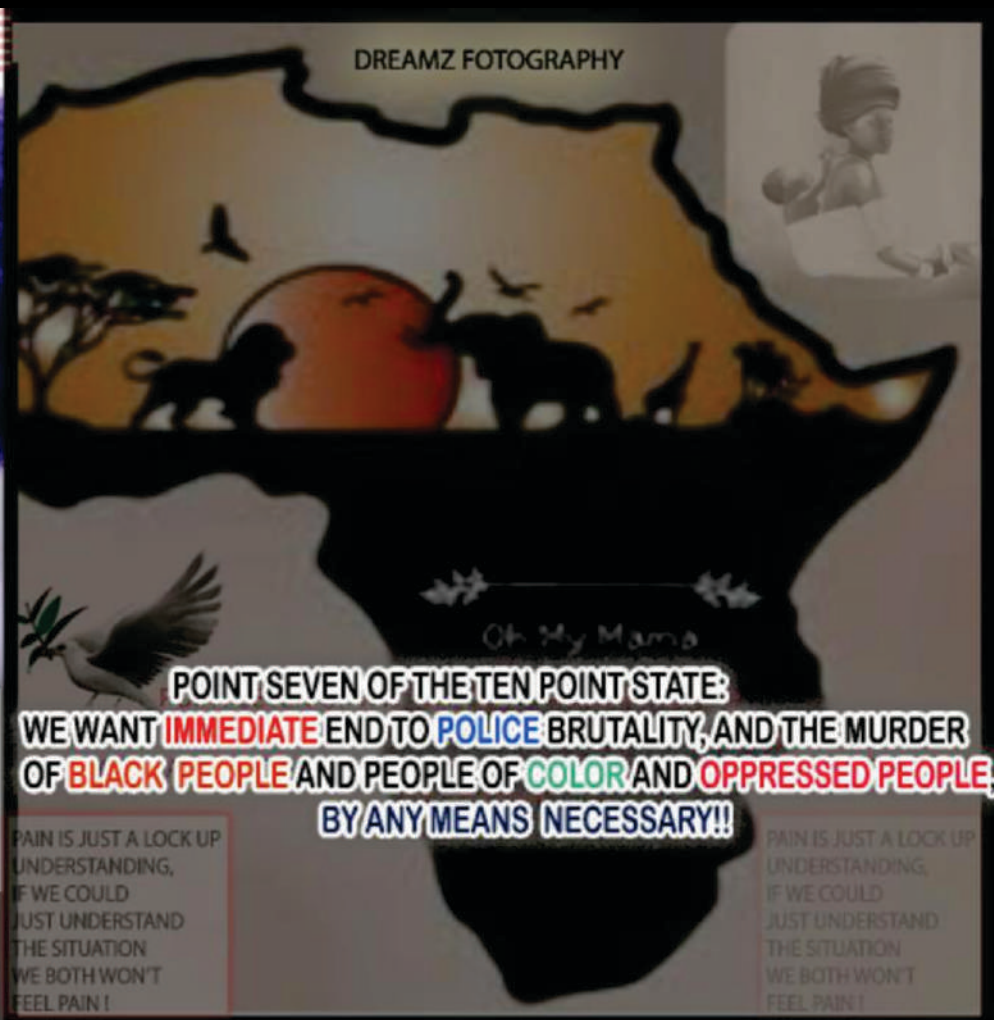

Some say Monday is a great day: I say it is a very long day.

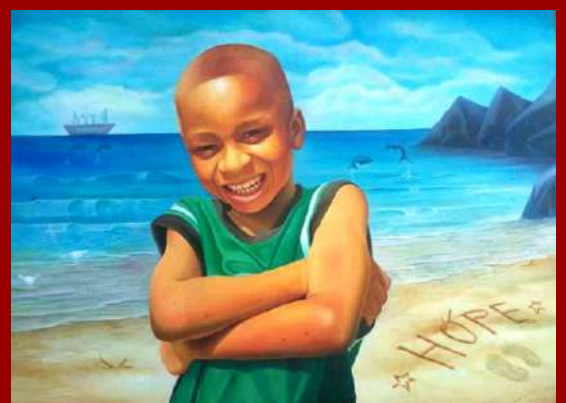
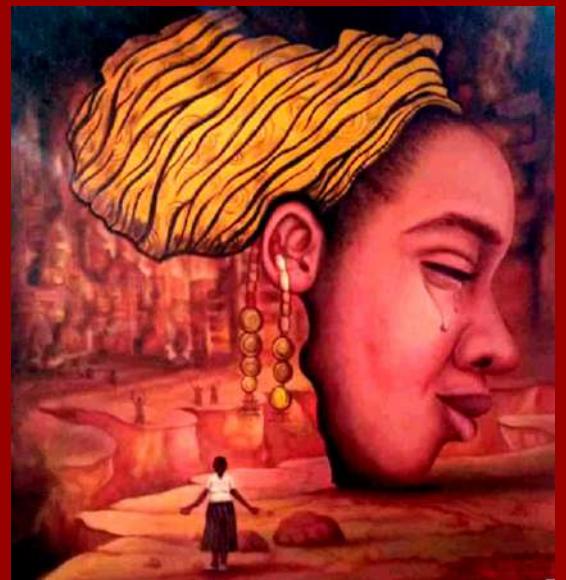
People say Monday sets the place for the rest of the week, I say it destroys the whole week energy.

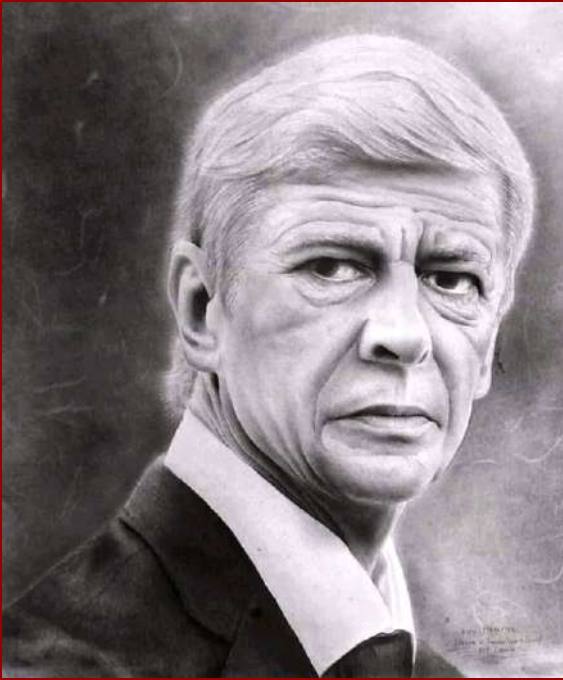
Some say Monday is a great way to start the week; I say it is a horrible way to start the week.
